HEAD TEACHER UPDATE

We have nearly completed two full weeks and I have been delighted with the start to the term. The behaviour has been excellent in the school and the children have already shown me some great examples of their learning. We have also welcomed our new Reception children who are attending full time this week. It has been great to meet them and my challenge is to learn all of their names as quickly as possible.

Thank you for the excellent punctuality and attendance to date. If we can keep that going all year, that would be perfect.

Last night the Life Bus arrived on site, the children are already excited about making a visit to it. The Life Bus will be with us for six days ensuring that each class receives their lesson.

Many year groups have begun their second project of the school year with exciting hooks to engage the children in their learning. It was great to see Year 5 mesmerised by Professor Plutonium who visited them to share his expertise and set them a science challenge.

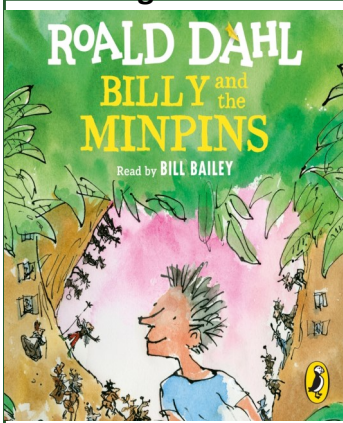
