Please do not use the doors that lead from the big playground to the small playground to walk through the school. This is to keep all of our children safe. Please enter our school in the correct manner.

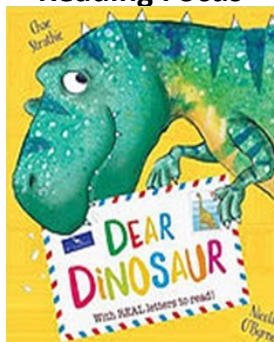
HOPE FOR FOOD
