If anyone has any garden storage containers that they no longer use, but are in good working condition, please can we have them. All of our storage boxes are on their last legs and need replacing.

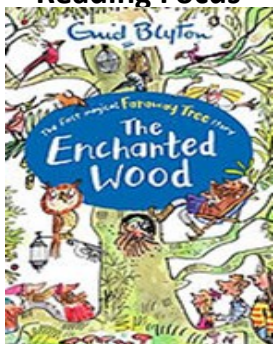
## WELLNESS DAY—5th APRIL
