On Monday, in assembly, the children were given the opportunity to share what they were looking forward to next year and also their worries. They all had a great day full of exciting things that they shared on their return. Our new Reception children also came for their visit to school which was very exciting. The new classes and staffing are being finalised and we will begin our in school transition the week beginning Monday 16th July. On that day, children will meet their new teachers and spend the afternoon in their new classrooms and at the end of the day a letter will be sent home with your child, informing you of their class teacher and class room. The children will have two further sessions during that week in their new classes, so that they are comfortable and confident on their return to school in September.

It has been a great pleasure to have had six students from Switzerland in school over the past two weeks. They are all looking to be teachers in the future and it was an opportunity for them to spend time in our school to improve their English. Each student, taught the class they were in about the life and culture of Switzerland.
