Jamie Jigsaw's amazing magic tricks!

Turn 4 coins into 5!

Secret set up: Attach a coin (with a dab of soap) to the underside of the table.

- Place 4 coins on the table.
- Brush the coins into your cupped left hand and at the same time release the hidden coin.
- Immediately make a fist around the coins and ask someone to touch your fist, open your hands to show there are now 5 coins!



Math Magic

Ask someone to write down a number between 1 and 50. Ask them to double it. Then add 10. Now divide it by 2.

Finally ask them to take away their original number. You can now tell them the number 5! they are thinking of! ...the number 5!
