ARE YOU A HOST FAMILY OR HOMESTAY PROVIDER FOR A YOUNG PERSON?

Bournemouth and Poole Local Safeguarding Children Board have published advice for host families – copies of which can be found in the main entrance or on our school website.

As a homestay family, there are certain rights and responsibilities in relation to the care of the young person living with you, whether you host for accredited or non-accredited schools.

- Language Schools must ask for a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check from you
- It is advisable to have a signed, written contract with the organisation
- Anyone under 16 staying in your home for more than 28 days must be registered with the Local Authority Private Fostering Team
- Hosts are advised to inform their insurance company to ensure appropriate cover
- Hosts are obliged to make sure that their premises are safe, otherwise may be liable
- You are advised to consult the fire service to carry out a fire risk assessment and also ensure that all gas appliances are covered by a current Gas Safe inspection certificate.

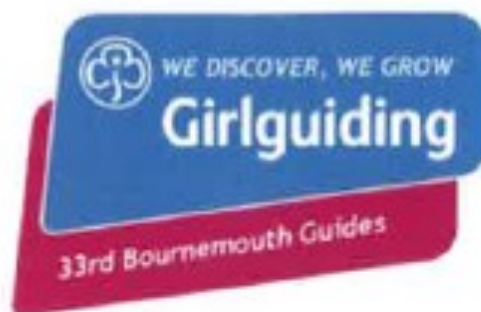
