

Curriculum Information Sheet

'This is where we learn'

Rationale: The teachers in Year 3 have had such a restful holiday that nothing has been organised for the children's return back to school. The children are therefore challenged to think about and carefully plan their learning environment, explaining and justifying their choices. What will their new classroom look like? Will they develop their sense of collective responsibility to ensure that their classroom serves a purpose? The children have two weeks to rise to this exciting challenge.

Learning Value: Emotional Intelligence

The children will:

- build lasting and meaningful relationships and develop effective interpersonal skills.
- name their feelings, talk about these in an open way and recognise how these feelings can affect their learning.
- recognise the emotions of other people, show empathy and respond appropriately.

In PSHE:

The children will discuss, plan and organise the resources in their classroom to create their learning environment, explaining and justifying their ideas and opinions. They will also create their own class charter, illustrating their rights and responsibilities as well as demonstrating their individual goals and aspirations for the year.

In English:

The children will write about their personal goals and achievements. They will also persuade the school librarian to stock their library with books which they have been able to justify. They will also present their new classroom to parents and visitors, explaining their outlook and vision for the year.

In Geography:

The children will create a plan of their classroom showing key zones and learning areas.
