They also built their own fires in the woods on which they cooked marshmallows and, on other occasions, took part in archery and caught over 60 crabs as a year group.

At the end of a (mostly) sunshine-filled week, staff and children left the Harrow site tired but with smiles on their faces and freshly formed memories that had been created. As staff, we were incredibly proud of our children's behaviour and the way in which they embraced each challenge put in front of them. Autograph books are still available at £3.50 and can be purchased from the school office. Grab one, while stocks last.


## ICE CREAM SALE
