The children in Y5 & Y6 will be performing carols at St. Thomas' Church on Thursday 19th December at 6pm. More details to follow.

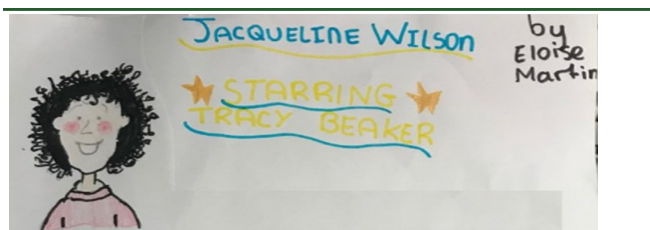
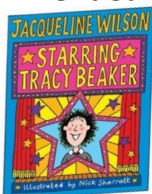
## SCHOOL PHOTOS
