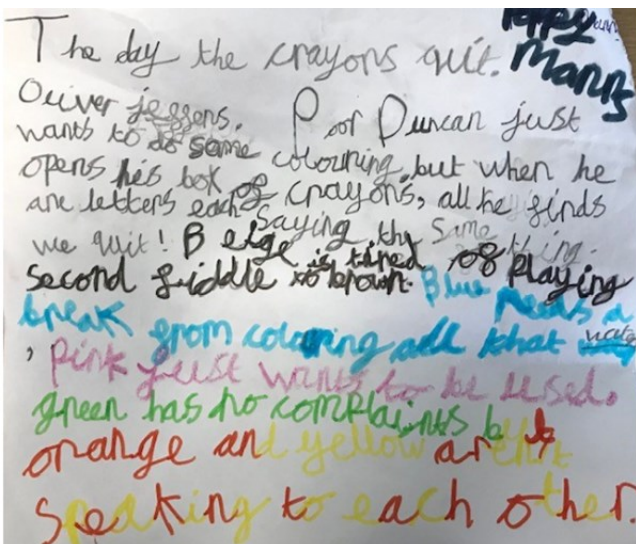
CHRISTMAS JUMPER AMNESTY

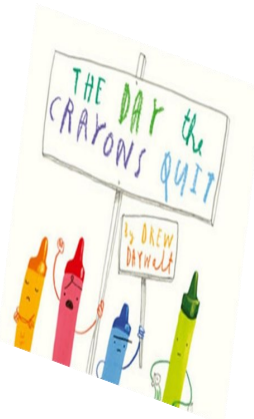
DRINKS
