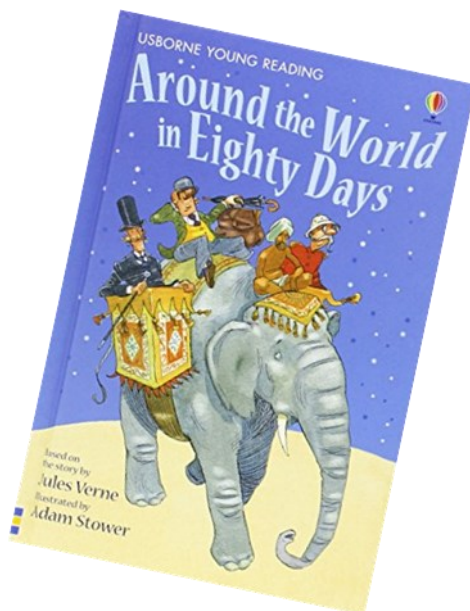
SCOOTERS AND BIKES
