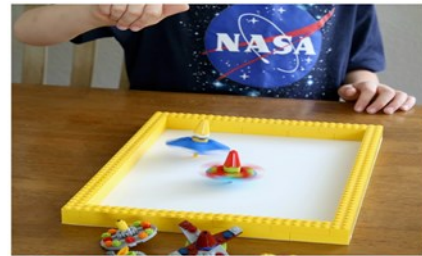

- 3 teaspoons of oil

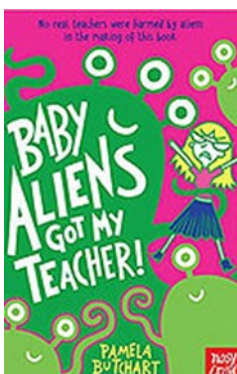
