### CHANGES TO PE TIMETABLES

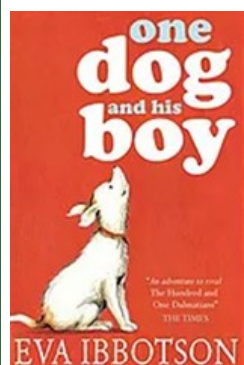
After half term, please be aware of the following changes to the PE Timetable.
