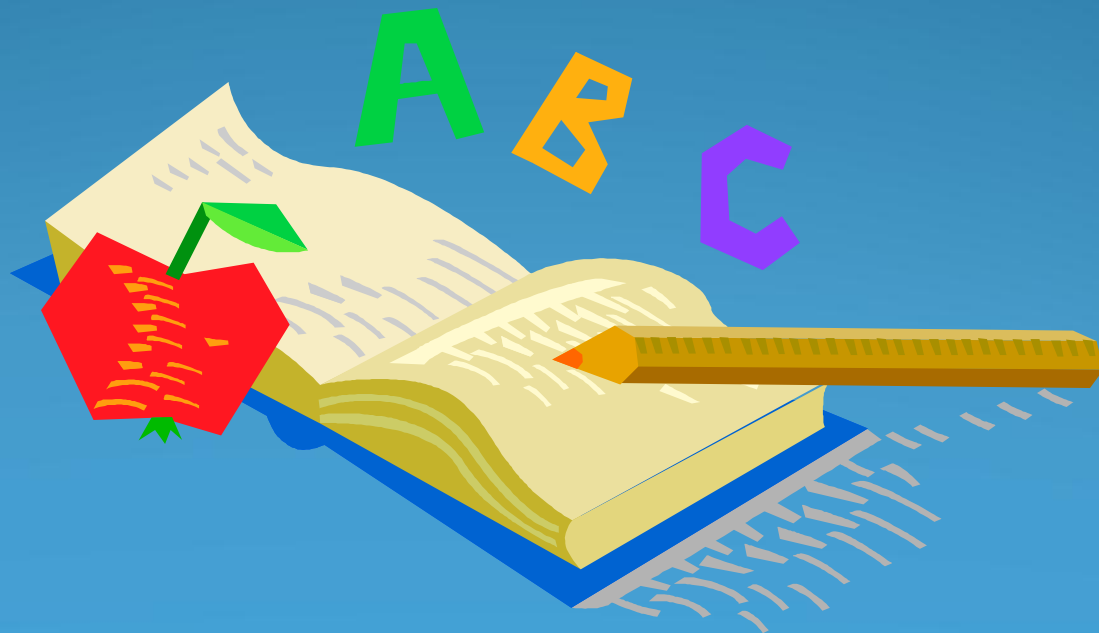

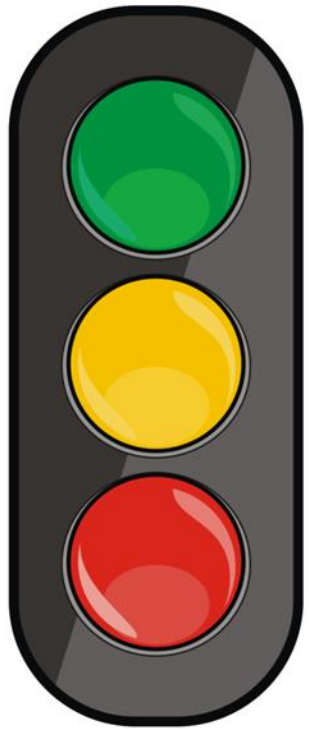
Behaviour

The class have created their own 'Class Charter', where we have agreed our class expectations.

However, all children are still required to adhere to the School Behaviour Policy and are aware of the traffic light system.

If a child has chosen to break a School/Class rule, they will be given a warning, if repeated there will be an appropriate sanction, such as a time out.

Behaviour: Traffic Light System

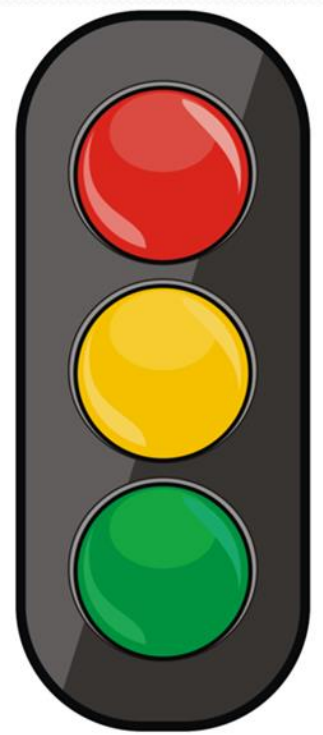


Green – Expected Behaviour

Orange – Verbal Warning

Red – Incurs Sanction

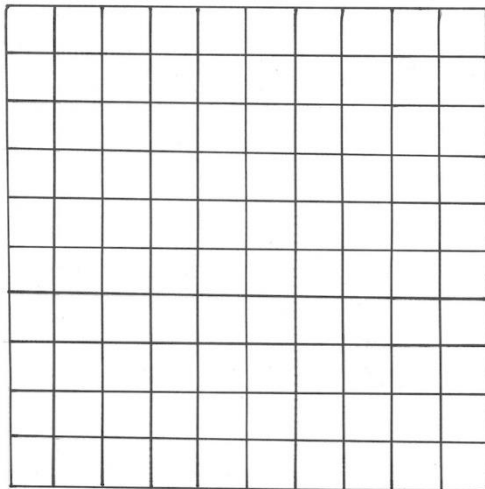

Reading



- Children who read regularly (ERIC time) share books and listen to adults reading, become readers!
- Phonics is taught daily.
- Every week, your child will take part in a variety of reading activities which will include phonics sessions, independent reading, shared reading and reading to an adult.
- Reading at Hill View – once your child reaches rainbow level in RWI they move onto fuller texts and learn other skills of how to read.

RWI



- Children are in coloured groups
- Different sounds taught each day
- Different book each week (this will come home and needs to be brought back every Monday)
- Sound chart in the front
- Fred talk and special friends

Hill View Curriculum

- Projects for the Year include: Heroes, The Troll, Unsinkable, Walk on the wild side (there are more!)
- Always linked to writing and then some other foundation subjects such as history, geography and art.
- Home learning linked to projects which you will receive in an email and children will bring home a more detailed outline. (You should have already had our first project overview)

Writing

- Linked to projects
- Free writes weekly
- Handwriting practise
- Daily writing in RWI
- Spelling in RWI and weekly focus words

Maths

- Power maths #
- Taught through Concrete, Pictorial and abstract
- Fluency
- Reasoning and problem solving opportunities
- Taught daily.
