physical features. Next week we are for our final walk in the wood where we will share our innovated stories with each other and fin-


gers crossed the Grufflao will come and listen too!

#### **TEXTILE BIN**


Please remember that we have a textile bin for all of your unwanted textiles. Please ensure they are clean and in a sealed bag to deposit into the bin.
