EYFS UPDATE

EYFS have been getting really stuck into our new project 'Step in Time'. The children came back to school in January to find a range of objects in the school hall to investigate. They found a typewriter, vinyl record, cd player, dominos and lots more. The children concluded after discussion that these objects were 'old'. We then challenged the children to be historians and find out more about the past and what it was like when their grandparents were younger. We began our project last week by thinking about the stages of life and growing up. The children created timelines and thought carefully about what changes happen at each life stage.

This week we have been exploring jobs in the past and how those jobs have changed over time. The children have also been choosing what they would like to be when they grow up. The children have produced some fabulous drawings of their chosen occupation and written some captions to explain why. We cannot wait to share our learning with our grandparents at the outcome of our project 'Grand Tea Party' on Thursday 2nd February! More information will follow about the outcome of this project.
