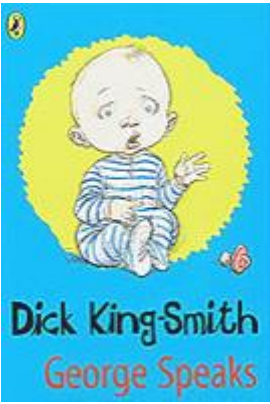


**ADDER & SMILE badges**
