Vacancies on the Board of Governors

At Hill View Primary, we currently have a full complement of parent governors but we are seeking help from parents in spreading the word to their friends and colleagues about the benefits of volunteering as a school governor so we can recruit external governors from the local community.

Governors make a valuable contribution to school leadership. It is a rewarding role, working towards a shared goal of providing a high-quality education for children and young people in our community. It also provides an opportunity for personal development, building skills and experience in areas such as project management and working as part of a senior team.

The Governing Board meets each half term to look at the big picture and the school's long-term goals. They are responsible for:

- undertaking induction training and ongoing development
- developing a vision and strategy for the school
- overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent
- holding the school leader to account to ensure that every pupil has the best possible education, looking at information and evidence on the school's progress and discussing with school leaders
- engaging with pupils, staff, parents and the school community to understand their views
- visiting the school to see plans working in practice, and listening to the views of staff, pupils and parents
- making decisions about issues such as pupil exclusions and staff disciplinary matters

Social Media and Child Abuse Images

An NSPCC investigation has revealed that UK police recorded a 66 per cent increase in child abuse image offences over the last five years.

In a recent [news blog](#), the NSPCC also argues unregulated social media is a central cause of the increase because social media companies are failing to prevent their sites being used to organise, commit and share images of [child sexual exploitation](#).

Recent research revealed:

- Snapchat is the site most used to share child abuse images.
- Facebook, Instagram and WhatsApp, were used in 33 per cent of child abuse crimes on social media.
- Virtual reality environments, such as the Metaverse which is accessed through VR headsets, are now involved in child sexual abuse image crimes.

The SWGfL supplies a series of [social media checklists](#) to help guide users through their profile settings on several social media platforms, protect their privacy and keep them safe from abuse on social media.

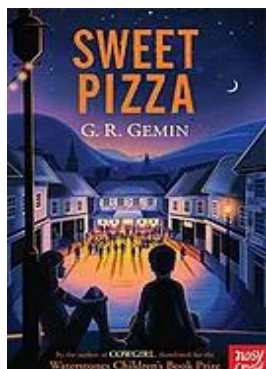
