### Music in the spring term at Hill View

All year groups have been busy in their class music lessons this term, with a variety of instrumental projects, composing and singing going on.



Year 1 have been learning about the dynamic dragon family and bumpy and smooth sounds, singing, doing actions and using percussion instruments.

Year 2 have been learning the recorder as a class – we are able to play 3 notes at the moment and can play 2 tunes.

Year 3 have been doing a whole class ukulele project – they gave a performance to years 1 and 2 in singing assembly last week which they really enjoyed.

Year 4 have been involved in a whole class guitar project, with a weekly lesson from a visiting guitar teacher. Our final piece has been 'Rockin' all over the world'

Year 5 have learnt about the History of Music, from the Baroque era to modern music, followed by creating a group composition based on a piece of abstract art.

Year 6 have learnt about what music brings to a film, with a project on film music, including creating a group score for part of the Sorcerer's Apprentice.

Private instrumental lessons also take place throughout the week – in guitar, clarinet, saxophone, piano, keyboard

Choir has been continuing for years 5 and 6 after school on a Wednesday – if you would like to join after Easter, please see Mrs Price for a letter.


