

Hill View Remote Learning provision. Summer Term '23

As you will be aware there is further planned industrial action that will result in partial closures of the school this Thursday 27th April and next Tuesday 2nd May due to Teacher Strikes. We apologise for the impact that this will have on many of our pupils who will be unable to attend school on these days. Only those pupils that have been invited to attend school can attend on these days due to the school prioritising available non-striking staff to safely supervise and educate certain year groups in line with guidance from our Trust and the Government.

If your child has been asked to not attend school because of this industrial action, we have made provision for them to continue to access learning. The main purpose behind this provision is to allow for structured consolidation of areas they may wish to revisit to deepen their learning.
