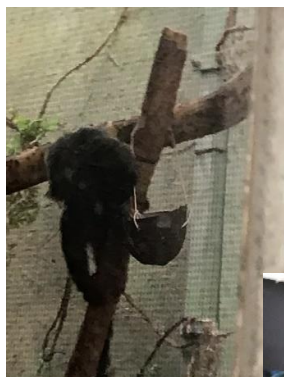
Reach For The Stars

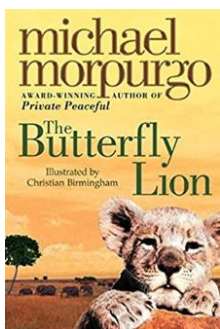
Reading Focus
