Prime Bottles/Drinks

We have seen an increase in the amount of children bringing in "Prime" bottles across all year groups. These are being used as a "status symbol" amongst children which is causing some upset and disruption. Please can we remind everyone that children should have plain water only in their bottles for school. Prime energy drinks and other energy drinks are not recommended for children aged under 18 due to the high caffeine content and other ingredients that are not suitable for children's developing organs. Prime energy contains a whopping 200mg of caffeine, compared to 86.4mg in a can of Monster Energy.

If any child brings in a Prime Bottle (regardless of the contents), they will be taken away and they will be given a plastic cup to use during the day. The Prime bottle will be handed back to the adult collecting them at the end of the day.

Named Personal Items

Please remember to name children's personal items – water bottles, jumpers, cardigans, lunch boxes etc. so that any mislaid items can be quickly returned to their owners.

Arriving Late to school


