We will sadly be saying goodbye to Mrs Jenny White and Mr Tom Clarke next week as they start new adventures in September.

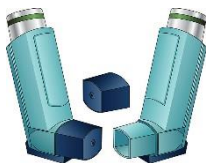


New classes from September 2023

Medication at school

If the school office currently has any all medication held in school will need to be collected next Friday, 21st July and taken home for the holidays.

Hot School Meals

From September 2023, the cost of a Hot School Lunch will be £2.60 each day. If your child is in Year R, Year 1 and Year 2 they are eligible for a Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM).

Orders must be made by midnight on Mondays for the following week ahead.
