

This year's Summer Reading Challenge has a physical activity theme and is called 'Ready, Set, Read!'.


It is games, play and sport related with an emphasis on keeping minds and bodies active over the holidays

Hot School Meals

From September 2023, the cost of a Hot School Lunch will be £2.60 each day. If your child is in Year R, Year 1 and Year 2 they are eligible for a Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM).

Orders must be made by midnight on Mondays for the following week ahead.

Alternatively, you can order meals for the whole term in advance.

The deadline for ordering meals for the first week back in September will be Monday 21st August

If no selection/order is made, then you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch from home.

We do not have spare lunches delivered into school to cover anyone that has forgotten.


