Below are two new updates regarding our revised behaviour approach following from feedback from parents and our new home reading platform, coming soon.

Behaviour

Firstly, I would like to remind you of the three school rules that we expect all children to follow, that is to be: Ready, Respectful and Safe. So you can help reinforce these with your child at home. Secondly, following feedback from parents and further reflection, we have slightly changed our Behaviour Policy so that we will no longer be putting or writing children's names onto a class traffic light that is visible to all other pupils, although the Traffic Lights will still be used as a reference point in each class. Staff now have personalised Traffic Light fans that will enable dealing with any behaviour matters to be less shaming, more consistently applied across the school.

Reading

We are thrilled to announce that our home reading records will from this year be completed via the digital platform: BoomReader. We will be setting this up with the Teachers and student's over the first couple of weeks of term. We understand that changing from paper diaries can feel daunting, but we understand the many benefits of using the app will make the experience of logging reading clear, enjoyable and more rewarding.
