Accessing Maths Flex – For KS2 Parents and Children

- 1) Log in using your child's username, password and school code.
- 2) Click on the tab at the top called 'My Stuff'.

3) Click 'Let's go' and that will take you to the main area.

4) The recommended path includes extra modules of learning from previous years that children can complete to earn extra nuggets.

5) Click on my courses on the left-hand side to access the homework.

6) Select the course – Maths Flex Year 5 – v3 (WR) – it will say your year group.

7) Your teacher will set you specific nuggets to complete each week. **Only complete the ones which are on your given homework sheet.**

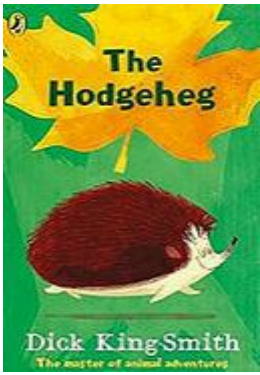
