


Hill View Primary School Reach For The Stars

Your child will have brought home their log-in PIN for Boomreader by now and we would encourage everyone who can to download the app and start logging their child's reading. Thank you to all those parents that have already done this it really does help the class teacher see how their children are practising their reading at home and at school. Remember this is a free app and it reduces our use and dependence on paper and managing all those diaries. Boom reader is in use across hundreds of schools and is an award winning piece of educational software that helps teachers and also further motivates children, particularly those that sometimes need an extra incentive to read. When children read they are awarded Gems and this can be up to twice a day. They are awarded randomly between 1-3 each time, just to keep it a little more interesting for the children. You can log in with/ or as your child and have fun with the avatar creator and reward cards. There is more information on our approach to reading and



- get an extra £2 for every £8 paid in
- get up to £2000 per child, per year or up to £4000 if your child is disabled
- pay for childcare for children up to 11 years or 17 years if they have a disability.


