Please can you make the school aware of any dietary requirements/ food preferences for your child. This helps to ensure that children are not accidentally given any food and/or drink products that they should not consume.

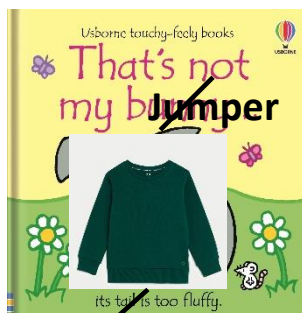

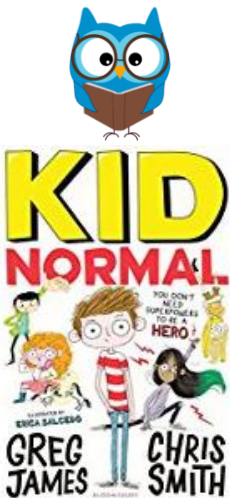
