

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As part of our next project, 'Unsinkable' Year 2 will be visiting Southampton SeaCity Museum on **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2024**. Whilst there, the children will be participating in a discovery session, personalised workshop and a tour of the museum. They will learn about significant artifices, key historical events and people linked to the titanic and much, much more! They will be given chances to experience all of this first hand and ask questions to further their own knowledge.

The cost of the trip is **£19.00** which covers transport and entry into SeaCity. This payment is required **by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2023**. Payments can be made by Wisepay which you can access using the link on the front page of the [school website](#). Once you have accessed the link, please select 'Trips and Visits', in the toolbar, on the left hand side. You should have already received your WisePay log-on details but, if you are unable to access this payment system, please contact the school office. Alternatively payments can be made in cash at the school office. **Please note that this trip will not be able to go ahead without full payment from all students.** Should you have any present financial difficulty, please don't hesitate to contact the school office to discuss this confidentially and a payment plan can be organised to accommodate your requirements. **By making payment for this trip on wisepay you are giving permission for your child to attend the Southampton SeaCity Museum on Thursday 11th January 2024.**

We will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am and will arrive back at Hill View before the end of the school day so your child can be collected as usual.

Your child will need to bring with them a day bag (preferably a small rucksack) in which they can put in a packed lunch and named water bottle. Children who have ordered a hot lunch for this day will be issued with a packed lunch on the day. Please do not include sweets or any fizzy drinks etc and **there should be no nut products.**

We would like ALL children to wear their normal school uniform as a means of being able to identify them. We advise that your child also brings a water-proof jacket.

May we politely remind you that no children should bring a mobile phone, cameras, money or toys.
