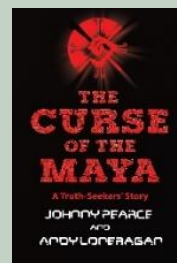

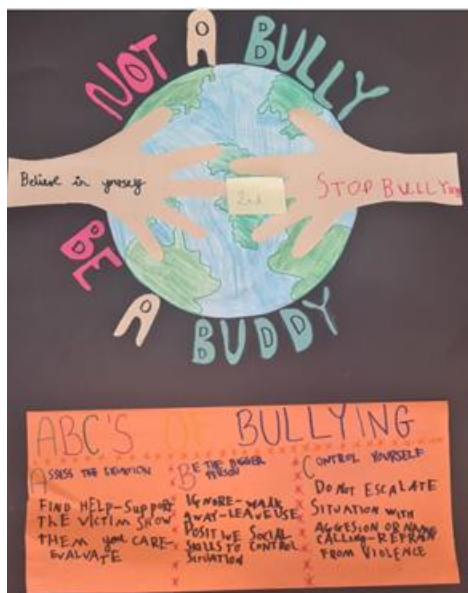
School Council – Anti-bullying posters

Please note that in the event of bad weather it may be cancelled.

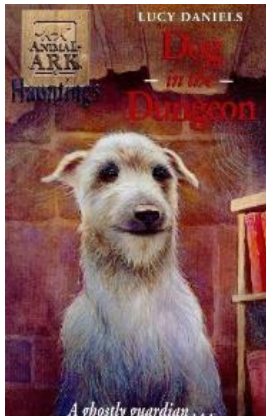
