Dear Parents / Carers

As part of our 'Walk on the Wild Side' project, Year 2 will be visiting Marwell Zoo on **Friday 19th April 2024.** The trip will engage the children by giving them first-hand opportunities to explore animals and their habitats. At the zoo, the children will learn key facts about a range of wild animals and use this information in their learning for our project.

The cost of the trip is **£17.50** which includes transport to and from the zoo. **This payment is required by Friday 22nd March 2024**. Once you have accessed the link, please select 'Trips and Visits', in the toolbar, on the left-hand side. You should have already received your WisePay log-on details but, if you are unable to access this payment system, please contact the school office. Alternatively, payments can be made in cash at the school office. By making payment for this trip on WisePay you are giving permission for your child to attend Marwell Zoo on Friday 19th April 2024. Please note that this trip will not be able to go ahead without full payment from all students so should you have any present financial difficulty, please don't hesitate to contact the school office to discuss this confidentially and a payment plan can be organised to accommodate your requirements.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9:00am and will arrive back at Hill View before the end of the school day so your child can be collected as usual.

Your child will need to bring with them a day bag (preferably a small rucksack) in which they can put in a packed lunch and named water bottle. Children who have ordered a hot lunch for this day will be issued with a packed lunch on the day. Please do not include sweets or any fizzy drinks etc and **there should be no nut products**.

We would like <u>ALL</u> children to wear their <u>PE kits with their school jumpers on top</u> as a means of being able to identify them. We advise that your child also brings a water-proof jacket and comfortable shoes as there will be a lot of walking.

May we politely remind you that no children should bring a mobile phone, cameras, money or toys.
