# Internet Connected Devices & Online Safeguarding at Home

Recently, we have had concerns from parents regarding language used by other children over internet connected devices when playing online games.

Please can we remind all parents that best practice is:

- children should not be left unsupervised when online
- any devices that are connected to the internet should be in a public area of the home so that you can listen in on any communication with others
- privacy settings for online devices should be set up so that your child can only talk or message specific people that you know in the real world
- children do not access age-inappropriate games/social media such as Snapchat (13+ years), WhatsApp (16+ years), Fortnite (13+ years)





Recommended Read Book of the week (Y1)




<u>George Speaks – Dick King-Smith</u>
