Street Fighter 6 includes elements of violence, blood, alcohol, tobacco, and suggestive themes. While the controls might be challenging for newcomers, the game offers tutorials and training features, along with a simplified “modern” control scheme. Supervised play is recommended for ages 12-14, while unsupervised play is suitable for ages 15 and up. Online interactions should be monitored by parents.
