

Dear Parents / Carers

As your child may have told you, we have started to play the flute in our weekly class music lesson. This has been made possible with funding from our local music hub, enabling us to hire 90 flutes for the project, which will run for the rest of the spring and into the summer term.

Our weekly lessons are on a **Tuesday** morning. The children will start by learning basic skills and then they will be able to bring their flute home. We will then progress to notes and simple tunes. **They will need to remember to bring their flute to school every Tuesday.** If your child frequently forgets their flute, they will have to keep it in school, as we must have them for our lessons. If you don't want to have the flute at home they can be stored in the music room.

Please encourage your child to look after their instrument – we will need to return them in the summer term. I have a record of the number on each flute and who it has been allocated to. For easy identification in school, it is a good idea to attach a keyring to the case.
