

In Design Technology (DT)

Children will explore, evaluate and discuss what tables are currently on the market thinking about which ones are the most stable and why. They will generate a set of criteria and design a new table for the Three Bears, annotating the parts and choosing the appropriate materials. Children will make the table, evaluating its strength and stability by testing, making necessary adjustments and improvements. Finally, they will present the finished table to the panel of judges, who will ask questions and want clear answers.

In English

Children will write in full sentences, write their reasons for choosing their design. They will listen to the original story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears, discuss the events and re-tell in your own words (T4W) and then write as a sequence of sentences to form a short narrative. After this the children will innovate the story, re-tell and then write the new version. Finally, they will create a final draft and use to share with someone else.

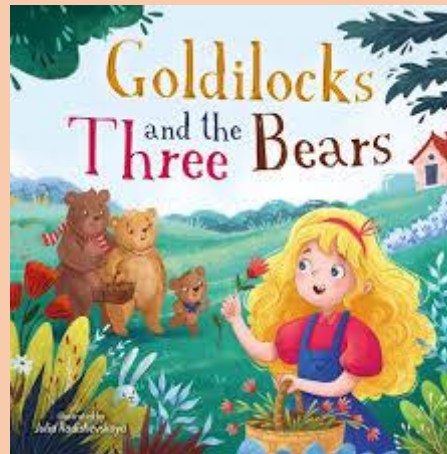
In Science

Children will investigate the structure of tables from in school and the materials used to make them. Record this information in a chart/diagram. They will create their own test to investigate the strength of chosen materials and suitability for making a table.

Having looked at how tables are made and strengthened children will work in teams of three to make a suitable replacement. They will need to consider the appropriateness of the materials, their properties and how they can be strengthened, so they do not collapse. As a surprise for the three bears, an innovated story will be written entitled 'Goldilocks and the Three...'. The final tables will be judged by a panel of experts and the stories enjoyed by everyone.
