In <u>History</u> the children will be learning:

- To recall and sequence key events.
- To compare the lives led by the Spartans and the Athenians.
- To understand the importance of the Olympic Games to the Ancient Greeks and make a valid comparison with the modern games.
- To recall that the first known democracy was in Athens during the Ancient Greek period but that some groups were excluded.
- To know the location and time period of Ancient Greece and draw comparisons with other civilisations and the present day.

## In English, the children will be:

- Independently completing the process of researching, planning, writing and editing a text that will form the basis of their talk as an 'expert'.
- Structuring their text with appropriate headings, sub-headings and bullet points.
- Extending their range of sentence structures.
- Developing reading stamina and comprehension skills.
- Developing their use of formal language.

For <u>Home Learning</u> the children will need to:

• Select, research and produce an artefact that will support their chosen line of historical enquiry and presentation in school.

In <u>Art, the children will be</u> learning:

- To analyse and evaluate Pop Art and the techniques used by artists such as Romero Britto.
- To experiment with colour and texture using paint, sand and glue on different surfaces.
- To create my own pattern using shapes, my own experiences and expressions.
