

#### In Geography:

As Geographers, the children will name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans, whilst identifying areas with natural and man-made wonders of the world. The children will understand the geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of Bournemouth in the United Kingdom, and of a small area in a the world.

#### In English:

We will be looking at different types of poetry and persuasive writing including adverts and brochures. The children will have the opportunity to write their own poem and create their own information booklet about wonders of the world.

#### In DT:

We will be looking at textiles and the children will learn how to sew using a running stitch. They will be making their own carpet full of colours of the world.
