

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of the final term in Year 6, we have organised a trip for the year group.

On **Thursday 6th June 2024**, we are going to be visiting the Royal Signals Museum in Blandford, to support our project about World War 2. This will be an exciting opportunity to explore Morse code and communication through radios. On the day of the visit, the children will leave school at approximately **9am** and will return to school by **3.20pm**. If we are delayed, we will send a group text to inform you of our estimated time of arrival back at school.

Your child will need to wear school uniform for the trip and will need to bring with them a day bag (preferably a small rucksack) in which they can put a packed lunch and named water bottle. Please do not include sweets or any fizzy drinks etc and there should be no nut products. Children who have ordered a hot lunch for this day will automatically be issued with a packed lunch on the day unless you cancel the order.

The cost of the trip is **£15.00** which includes transport to and from the museum. **This payment is required by Friday 3rd May 2024**. Payments for this can be made by using **WisePay** which you can access using the link on the front page of the school website: <http://www.hillviewprimary.co.uk>. Once you have accessed the link, please select 'Trips and Visits', in the toolbar, on the left hand side. You should have already received your WisePay log-on details but, if you are unable to access this payment system, please contact the school office. **By making payment for this trip on WisePay you are giving permission for your child to attend the Royal Signals Museum on Thursday 6th June 2024**. Alternatively, payments can be made in cash at the school office. Please note that these trips will not be able to go ahead without full payment from all students. If you have any present financial difficulty, please do not hesitate to contact the school office to discuss this confidentially and a payment plan can be organised to accommodate your requirements.
