## Where in the world would you like to visit?

Your Home Learning challenge is to create an information guide about a country you would particularly like to visit. You will be able to use the geography skills and the writing skills that we work on in class to help you produce an interesting and creative guide to inform your class colleagues.



### As a geographer you may include some of the following:

- a map labelled with key cities, bordering countries and bodies of water
- graphs to show climate such as rainfall and temperature
- detail of the geographical features
- detail of indigenous wildlife
- detail of key tourist attractions
- an aspect of particular interest to you

### As a Y6 writer you can include:



- formal language and sentence structure
- relevant technical vocabulary e.g. longitude
- titles and sub-headings
- paragraphs of linked information



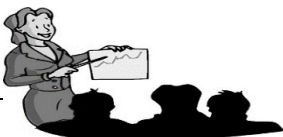
### As a presenter you can:

- use your information text to support your presentation
- speak at a volume and pace that your class can hear and follow

### You might like to:



- create a quiz for the end of your presentation
- bring in relevant resources to support your writing
- watch television presenters for tips on presentation
- include drawings or images to support your writing
- present your work as a PowerPoint, as a leaflet or use your creativity to invent your own format
