Year 5 Update



Pupil Absence



If your child is going to be absent from school, please contact the school office:

If leaving a message or sending an e-mail, please give the child's name & Class/Year Group. We are required to record the **Reason for their Absence.** We need specific details rather than just "unwell". Please let us know your child's **specific symptoms** e.g. temperature, cold/flu symptoms, vomiting etc. Providing these details will prevent us calling you.

Please refer to the <u>NHS website</u> for advice regarding whether to keep your child away from school if they are unwell.

POLITE REMINDER TO PARENTS

Unfortunately, we have received complaints from several sets of parents about children (below Year 6) who are being left alone outside school for a significant amount of time before the school gate opens in the morning. In addition, these children have been reported to have been physically aggressive, playing dangerously near the road and using unacceptable language. We will not accept this behaviour from any child that attends Hill View as they are not displaying respectful behaviour and are not following school values or expectations.

If your child is being left without adequate supervision, we will use the CCTV to identify them and speak with you about it – this is a safeguarding concern and if it continues, we will need to report further incidents to Children's Social Care.

Unless you have informed the school that your child is walking to or from school alone (in Year 6), no child should be left unattended either in the school office or waiting in the line on the pavement before or after school; we do not have capacity to supervise them, and other parents should not be expected to supervise children who are not their own without previous agreement between parents.




PTFA Update




