## Year 4 Update

Year 4 have been learning all about India this half term- the food, the climate, the rivers and many more aspects of Indian culture. As part of our Design and Technology skills, we completed some market research about the different dips that Indian cuisine is famous for. We were lucky enough to have Chef Dayman from The Royal Academy of Culinary Arts and Bournemouth and Poole College to lead a cooking session to awaken our senses to Indian spices. We worked as a team to prepare, cut, peel and grate the ingredients we needed for produce raita and a red lentil daal. We then invited our families into school to join us for a tasting session and enjoy reading the booklets we made about India. It was lovely to see so many of our Year 4 community come along to support us and perhaps try something new! Have you ever tried an Indian daal?

### Clarification

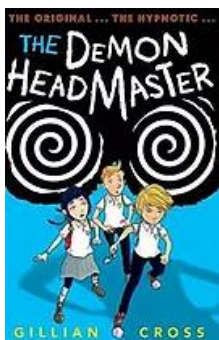
