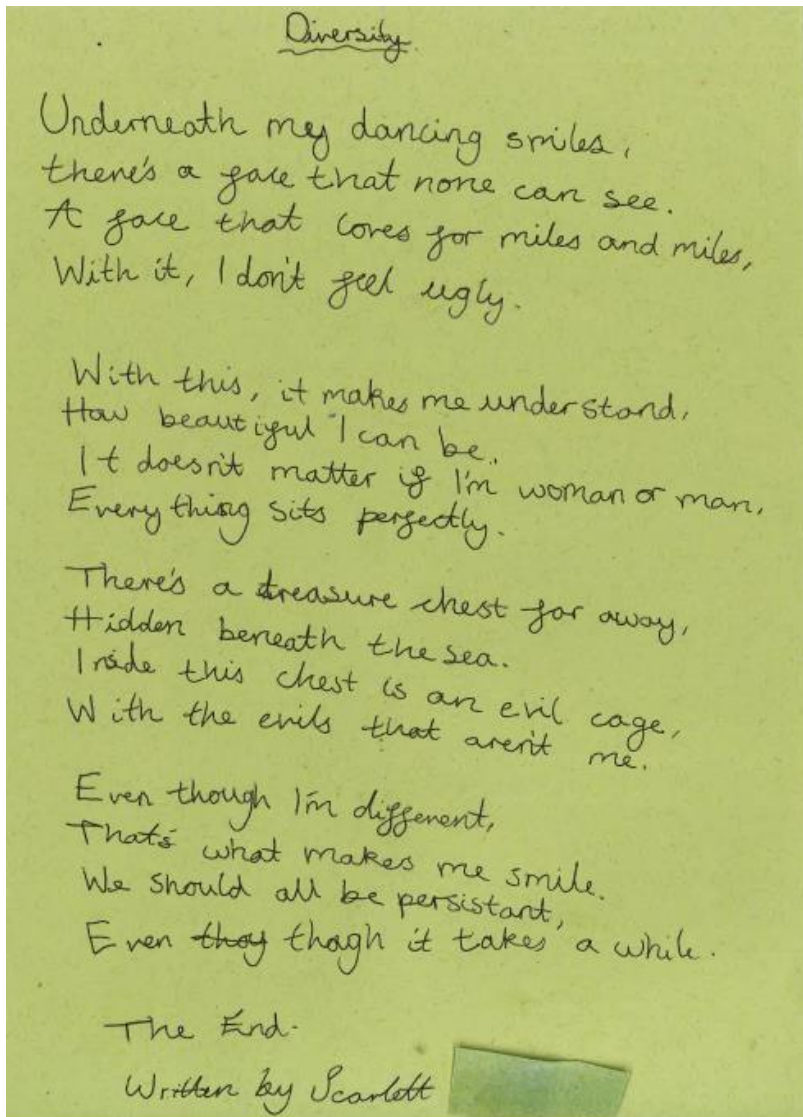

# Staying Home Alone – Advice from the NSPCC

With the summer holidays coming and as your child gets older, they may want a bit more freedom to be independent. Are they ready to stay at home alone?



**Is it legal to leave a child home alone?** A child who isn't old enough or who doesn't feel comfortable should never be left home alone. If this is the case, it's best to look into childcare options that might work for your family.

There's no legal age a child can be left home alone, but it's against the law to leave a child alone if it puts them at risk. Every child matures differently, so it would be almost impossible to have a "one size fits all" law. Parents can be prosecuted if they leave a child unsupervised 'in a manner likely to cause unnecessary suffering or injury to health': [gov.uk/law-on-leaving-your-child-home-alone](http://gov.uk/law-on-leaving-your-child-home-alone)

**As your child gets older, talk to them about how they feel about being left home alone.** If they're worried, work out what parts of being home alone worry them. Do they feel safe in the neighbourhood? Are they afraid of the dark? Talk about anything that's bothering them and discuss a solution. Understanding why they don't feel comfortable will give you an idea of how to help – or why they might not be ready to be left alone.

We would always recommend leaving a child younger than 12 years old with family, a friend or in childcare.

Our tips to keep your child safe home alone	
Set some ground rules	+
Agree what they'll do while you're out	+
Make sure they're safe online	+
Practise what to do in an emergency	+
Be clear what time you'll be back	+
Check in with them every now and then	+
Put dangerous objects and substances out of sight	+
Build up slowly	+

Please would you remind your child/children that they need to behave safely on the roads, both for their own sakes and for the safety of other children and adults, especially if not accompanied by adults. We will be looking at and monitoring the CCTV and reporting to parents if this does not improve.

Your children are also representing the school and we will not tolerate these poor choices as it does not follow our ASCENT values.

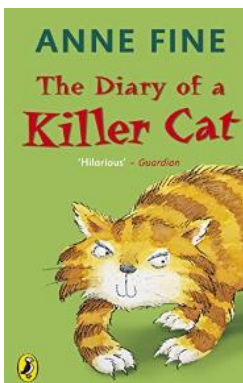


### Recommended Read Book of the week (Y3)
