As a historian you may include some of the following:

- Interviews
- Video clips

As a Y6 writer you can include:



- formal language and sentence structure
- relevant technical/historical vocabulary
- titles and sub-headings
- paragraphs to organise information



As a presenter you can:

- use your information text to support your presentation
- speak at a volume and pace that your class can hear and follow

You might like to:



- create a quiz for the end of your presentation
- bring in relevant resources to support your writing
- watch television presenters for tips on presentation
- include drawings or images to support your writing
- present your work as a PowerPoint, as a leaflet or use your creativity to invent your own format
