

Heroes

In English:

The children will be developing their fact writing skills, focusing on using the past and present tense. They will continue to work on the use of conjunctions in their writing to extend their sentences. For example, and, so, but, if, when, that, because, or. The children will also be learning to use pronouns and proper nouns.

In P.S.H.E:

The children will be thinking about their own goals and how to achieve them, learning to persevere even when they find a task difficult. The children will think about how they can use the learning values to achieve something they want.

In History:

The children will be learning about the class names within Year 2 and will have the opportunity to research through the use of technology and information texts.

Following a rescue mission to get Lily the cat down from the hut roof, children will be inspired to think about what being a hero means to them. Children will research and explore historical figures and recording their findings in information booklets and their own responses and feelings in letters and diary entries. They will discuss the improvements and impact these historical figures have had on society, this will lead them to think about who has had an impact on their life and why. The children will invite their chosen hero to the 'Pride of Hill View' ceremony and award them with a handcrafted clay medal.
