All children will need to bring a small bag or rucksack to carry their packed lunch, which should include a bottle of water. No FIZZY drinks please. If you take up the Universal Free School Meal through Forerunner, any ordered lunches for this day will automatically be converted to a packed lunch and delivered to the school on the morning of the trip.

Your child will need to wear school uniform. If your child is prone to travel sickness and needs medication to be administered on the day, please ensure that you have filled in a medical form, available from the School Office and hand both the medication and the completed slip to your child's class teacher.
