
Reading

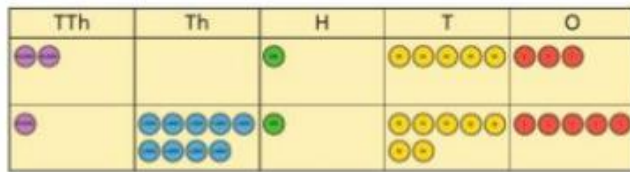

I need to exchange 10 tens for a 100.

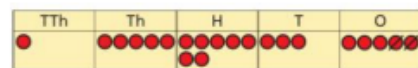

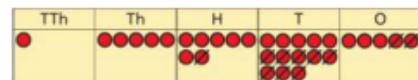

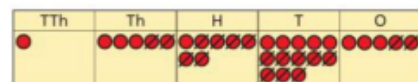
$$15,735 - 2,582 = 13,153$$
