

Y4 Paultons Park Trip

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming Year 4 trip, which will take place as part of our 'Fun at the Fair' project. We are excited to announce that we will be visiting Paulton's Park! Whilst there, children will participate in a workshop exploring how electrical circuits work, apply their knowledge of electricity and explore the range of rides at the park. The trip will support the children's understanding of fairground rides and electricity, whilst giving them an opportunity to explore the park. The date for the trip is **Monday 3rd March 2025.**

The cost of the trip is £20.00, which covers transport and entry into Paultons Park. This payment is required by Friday 7th February. Payments can be made by WisePay which you can access using the link on the front page of the school website: http://www.hillviewprimary.co.uk. Once you have accessed the link, please select 'Trips and Visits', in the toolbar, on the left-hand side. Alternatively, payments can be made in cash (exact money please) at the school office. By making payment for this trip you are giving permission for your child to attend the Paultons Park on Monday 3rd March 2025. Please note that this trip will not be able to go ahead without full payment from all students, so should you have any present financial difficulty, please don't hesitate to contact the school office to discuss this confidentially and a payment plan can be organised to accommodate your requirements.

Your child will need to bring with them a day bag (preferably a small rucksack) in which they can put in a packed lunch and named water bottle. Please do not include sweets or any fizzy drinks etc and there should be no nut products. Children who have ordered a hot lunch for this day will automatically be issued with a packed lunch on the day. We would like ALL children to wear their PE kit and trainers, with their school jumper/cardigan- as a means of being able to identify them. We advise that your child also brings a water-proof jacket. May we politely remind you that no children should bring a mobile phone, cameras, money or toys.

If you are available to help out on this day and join us on the trip, please speak to your child's class teacher or make contact with the school office.
